Reasons for Conditions

1. That the development be carried out and completed in strict conformity with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.

2. That the structure shall be removed on or before 31st December, 1981 unless before that date permission for its retention is granted by the Planning Authority or by the Minister on appeal.

2. To enable the effect of the development on the amenities of the area to be reviewed, having regard to the conditions then obtaining.

3. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.

3. In the interests of public safety and avoidance of fire hazard.

4. That the water supply and drain arrangements, including disposal of surface water, be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.

4. In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
