## A Chara

With reference to your planning application received here on the 26/11/'76 in connections with the above, I wish to inform you that before your application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963, the following additional information must be submitted in quadruplicate:-

- 1. Murther information is required which should provide for :-
- (a) Adequate and satisfactory evidence that the site proposed is suitable for septic tank drainage, with revised septic tank arrangements.
- (b) Satisfactory evidence is also required that an adequate and potable water supply is available. <u>NOTE:</u> The applicant must discuss these requirements with the Health Inspector's Department so that a satisfactory location for the proposed house septic tank and private water supply can be agreed before submitting revised plans.
- (c) Revised access details providing for a common entrance for the 2-sites which is to be cut back a minimum distance of 20-ft., from the road boundary together with adequate traffic visibility splays.
- NOTE: The applicant must consult with the Roads Department regarding these matters.
