A PERMISSION/~~Approval~~ has been granted for the development described below subject to the undermentioned conditions:
retention of existing sports pavilion and use of lands as sports fields at Killinarden Road, Old Barn, Tallaght.

Conditions

Reasons for Conditions

1. That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.
2. That the drainage arrangements, including the design, location and satisfactory operation of the septic tank be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council. The applicants must consult with the Health Inspector's Department, 9, Rutland Place, with regard to these matters.
3. That adequate off-street carparking facilities related to the scale of development and activities proposed be provided. The adjoining public road is not to be used for carparking.
4. That any necessary requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be adhered to in respect of this development.
5. That the structure and lands be used for sports and recreational purposes as set out in the application, dated 29/10/76, and any proposed change of use shall be subject to the approval of the Planning Authority or the Minister, on appeal.

1. To ensure that the development be in accordance with the permission and effective control be maintained.
2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
3. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
4. In the interest of public safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.
5. To enable the effect of the development on the amenities of the area having regard to the conditions then obtaining.
