With reference to your Planning Application received here on the 4th October, 1976, in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963, the following additional information must be submitted in quadruplicate:-

1. The application and newspaper advertisement refers to site 4 Robin Villas. The location map submitted with the application identifies the site of the development as being at the corner of Waterstown Avenue and Palmerstown Road. Clarification is required as to where the site of the proposed development is located.
2. The applicant is requested to publish a further notice in accordance with the requirements of the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963, in at least one of the following newspapers Irish Independent, Irish Times, Irish Press, Evening Herald or Evening Press. Evidence of such a public notice to be submitted to the Planning Authority with the additional information requested in item 1 above. It is noted that members of the public visited the Council's offices and viewed the current application.
