APPEAL by McGoff Moldings Limited of Woodlands, Naas, County Wildare, against the decision made on the 7th day of October, 1978, by the Council of the County of Dublin deciding to refuse a permission for development comprising open storage for two years of cars, industrial construction and farming machinery on a site at St. Brigid's/Brideswell Compons, New Road, Newlands Cross, Clondalkin:

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1983 and 1976, permission is hereby refused for the said development for the reasons set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULI

- It is an objective of the planning authority, as expressed in the County Development Plan, to reserve the area in which the site is located for the preservation and improvement of residential emenity. This objective is considered reasonable and the proposed development would be in conflict with it and seriously injurious to the residential amenities of the area because of its visual impact.
- 2. The proposed development would endanger public safety because it would generate traffic movements directly onto a heavily-trafficked national primary road at a new access point and these movements would conflict with the free flow and safety of traffic on the road.
