In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/319/76, dated 24th March, 1976, decide to refuse;

~~OUTLINE PERMISSION~~; PERMISSION; ~~APPROVAL~~,
for proposed ^{by lateral} advertising panels on site E, Rathfarnham Shopping
Centre,

for the following reasons:

1. The proposed advertisement sign would be located on the footpath at the public entrance to the supermarket and at a point where vehicular traffic approaches from four directions. The siting of the sign at this location would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard and cause obstruction to pedestrian traffic.

The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
