In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/810/76 dated 22nd March, 1976 decide to refuse:

for Proposed double sided advertising panel attached to lamp-post.....

at Rathfarnham Shopping Centre, Butterfield Avenue, (Site H).....

for the following reasons:

1. The proposed structure adjacent to the public road would constitute a distraction to drivers and would be likely to endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard.
2. The proposed structure, together with other advertising structures proposed in the vicinity would result in a proliferation of advertising structures and, would thereby be injurious to the residential amenity of the area.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
