APPEAL by Joe Walsh of Greenhills Road, Tallaght, County Dublin, against the decision made on the 24th day of September, 1976, by the Council of the County of Dublin deciding to refuse to grant permission for the retention of a house on a site at Greenhills Road, Tallaght, in accordance with plans and particulars lodged with the Council:

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, it is hereby decided, for the reason set out in the First Schedule hereto, to grant permission for the retention of the said house in accordance with the said plans and particulars, subject to the conditions specified in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto, the reasons for the imposition of the said conditions as set out in column 2 of the said schedule.

SECOND SCHEDULE (Continued)

Column 1 - Conditions	Column 2 - Reasons for Conditions
4. If not already paid, the developer shall pay a sum of money to the Dublin County Council as a contribution towards the said Council's expenditure on the provision of a public water supply in the area. The amount to be paid and the time and method of payment shall be agreed between the developer and the said Council or, failing agreement, shall be as determined by An Bord Pleanála.	4. The provision of this service in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the cost of providing the service.
