DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, it is hereby devided, for the reason set out in the First Schedule hereto, to grant permission for the erection of the said extension in accordance with the said plans and particulars, subject to the condition specified in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto, the reason for the imposition of the said condition being as set out in column 2 of the said Second Schedule and the said remaission is hereby granted subject to the said condition.
