- I. The site is located in the Dublin Mountain zone in an area of high scenic amenity falue which it is the policy of the Planning Authority to preserve and protect from all but essential development. The proposed development would not be in accordance with this policy and as such would be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
- There are no public piped services available to serve the development.
- 3. The proposed development would be premature by resean of the said deficiencies in the provision of water supply and sewerage facilities and the period within which such xx deficiencies may reseanably be expected to be made good.
- 4. No evidence has been provided to Show the suitability of the soil for the disposal of septic tank effluent.
- 5. No evidence of the potability of the proposed wall water has been submitted.
- 6. The olts is maximum served by a very substandard laneway, having 8-ft. carriageway and an overall width of I2-ft.
- 7. The junction of this laneway with the L.20I, is totally inadequate in the matter of alignment and the provision of vision eplays. Generation of traffic turning movements on this junction would andanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard.
