- high scenic amenity value which it is the policy of the Planning Authority to preserve and protect from all but essential development. The proposed development would not be in accordance with this policy and as such would be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
- 2. There are no public piped services available to serve the development.
- 3. The proposed development would be premature by reseon of the said deficiencies in the provision of water supply and sewerage facilities and the period within which such deficiencies may reasonably be expected to be made good.
- 4. No evidence has been provided to show the suitability of the soil for the disposal of septic tank effluent.
- 5. No evidence of the potability of the proposed well water has been submitted.
- 6. The site is served by a very sub-standard laneway, having 6-ft., carriageway and an overall width of 12-ft.
- 7. The junction of this leneway with the L201, is totally inadequate in the matter of alignment and the provision of vision glays. Generation of traffic turning movements on this junction would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard.
