1. That the development be carried out and completed in strict conformity with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required. 2. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development. The premises are not to be occupied until the Chief Fire Officer's requirements are met. 3. That the water supply and drainage arrangements, including the disposal of surface water, be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council. 4. That all necessary measures be taken by the contractor to prevent the spillage or deposit of clay, rubble, or other debris on adjoining roads during the course of the development. 5. That any necessary revisions to the access arrangements be agreed with the Roads Engineer for the purpose of ensuring that adequate setting down area is provided. The necessary frontage footway constructional works are also to be agreed with the Roads Department. 6. That details of the proposed boundary and landscaping works be submitted to and approved by the County Council after consultation with the Parks Department.	1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained. 2. To protect the safety of persons occupying or employed in the structure or any adjoining structures. 3. In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964. 4. To protect the amenities of the area. 5. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area. 6. In the interest of amenity, proper planning and development of the area.
