APPLICANT: Templeogue House Residents Association.

In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/2660/76 dated 24th August, 1976.

decide to refuse:

~~OUTLINE PERMISSION~~; PERMISSION; ~~APPROVAL~~

for Proposed retention of temporary road access from Templeogue-Tallaght  
Road to Templeogue House Estate.

for the following reasons:

1. The proposed temporary access onto the main Templeogue-Tallaght Road at this location would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard, as the overall road width is only 30ft. and the present average annual daily traffic is ~~xxxx~~ in excess of 17,000 vehicles. This compares unfavourably with the average annual daily traffic of 14,500 recorded on the Neas Road dual carriageway adjacent to Saggart, and because of inadequate carriageway width which is approx. 22 ft. right turning vehicles into the estate would obstruct the free movement of traffic and would tend to create serious traffic congestion on this heavily trafficked national secondary route within the junction approach area to the Templeogue Bridge Traffic signalled junction.

2. The proposed erection of temporary or permanent bollards at the location shown would obstruct the circulation and free flow of traffic within the estate and would deny vehicular access to local shops, churches and schools and would thus not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
