(1) Development to be carried out and completed in conformity with C.I.E. drawing No. QS/2/1, dated 25/1/75.	(1) To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission, and effective control be maintained.
(2) That the applicants indemnify the County Council against any claims made against the Authority as a result of the presence of the structure on a public property.	(2) In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
(3) That the applicant makes satisfactory arrangements for the maintenance, repair and upkeep of the structure.	(3) In the interests of amenity and public safety.
(4) That the applicant accepts responsibility for the removal of the structure at his own expense, if such is necessary, for the purpose of road widening, reconstruction or repair and for the repair, replacement and renewal of any services installed in the public street.	(4) In the interests of the proper planning and development of the area.
(5) That the lighting of panels be so carried out as not to cause excessive glare or distraction to road users or adjoining property owners, and that the hours of lighting shall not extend beyond the hours of lighting of the adjoining street lights.	(5) In the interests of public safety and amenity.
(6) That the proposed shelter shall be set back ten feet from the edge of the hard shoulder of the adjoining carriageway.	(6) In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
