Reasons for Conditions

1. Subject to the conditions of this permission the development to be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application.

2. That the water supply and drainage arrangements including the disposal of surface water & be in accordance with the requirements of the Co. Council. The applicant must consult with the Sanitary Services Department with regard to these matters in view of agreement of any additional arrangements.

3. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Prevention Officer be strictly adhered to and complied with in this development ~~(as attached)~~

4. Before development commences, approval under the Building Bye-laws be obtained, and all conditions of that approval be observed in the development.

5. That a financial contribution in the sum of £400 (four hundred pounds) be paid by the proposer to the Dublin County Council towards the cost of provision of public services in the area of the proposed development and which facilitate the development, this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on the site.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.

2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.

3. In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.

4. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.

5. The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the cost of providing the services.
