In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/2711/76 dated 7th July, 1976.

for Proposed advertising sign at Firhouse Inn, Firhouse Road,

for the following reasons:

1. The site is located in an area zoned to preserve an area of high amenity. The development proposed which envisages the erection of an additional large advertising hoarding for commercial purposes would contravene materially this objective would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area and would seriously injure the amenities of the area.
2. The proposed advertising hoarding by reason of its size, scale and location immediately adjoining a main traffic route would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard because of the additional distraction and confusion of vehicles on this heavily trafficked main road.

The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
