## Reasons for Conditions

1. That the development be carried out and completed in strict conformity with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.
2. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be adhered to in the development. The structure is not to be occupied until these requirements have been fully met; these requirements are as follows:-
  1. Adequate and suitable first-aid fire fighting equipment.
  2. Approved type fire alarm.
  3. Adequate fire fighting facilities, including provision of adequate and suitable hydrants in positions to be agreed with Fire Brigade.
  4. That the water supply and drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.
  5. That before development commences, Building Bye-laws approval shall be obtained, and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.

1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission, and effective control maintained.
2. In the interests of public safety and avoidance of fire hazard.
3. In order to comply with Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
