APPEALS by Denis J. Smyth of "Parknacoon", 235 Templeogue Road, Templeogue, Dublin and Others against the decision made on the 9th day of April, 1975, by the Right Honourable the Lord Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of Dublin deciding to grant subject to conditions a permission to Reverend Father M. Alexander, for the construction of a temporary roadway at Our Lady's School, Templeogue Road, Templeogue, in accordance with plans and particulars lodged with the Corporation:

DECISION: Pursuant to subsections (5) and (9) of section 26 of the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963, and after consideration of the report of the person who conducted an oral hearing of the said appeal, it is hereby decided to grant permission for the construction of the said temporary roadway in accordance with the said plans and particulars, subject to the conditions specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, the reasons for the imposition of the said conditions being as set out in column 2 of the said Schedule and the said permission is hereby granted subject to the said conditions.
