APPEALS by Denis J. Smyth of "Parknadoon". 235 Templeogue Pord, Templeogue, Dublin and Others against the decision made on the 9th day of April, 1975, by the Night Honourable the Lord Mayor, Aldermen and Burgasses of Publin deciding to mant subject to conditions a termination to Heverend Mother H. Alexander, for the construction of a temporary roadway at Our Lady's School, Templeogue, in accordance with plans and particulars lodged with the Corporation:

DECISION: Pursuant to subsections (5) and (9) of section 26 of the local Government (Planning and Sevelopment) Act, 1963, and after consideration of the report of the person who conducted an oral hearing of the said appeal, it is hereby decided to grant permission for the construction of the said temporary roadway in accordance with the said plans and particulars, subject to the conditions specified in column 1 of the Schedula hereto, the reasons for the imposition of the said conditions being as set out in column 2 of the said Schedule and the said permission is hereby granted subject to the said conditions.

## SCHEDULE

## 1. The readway shall be removed and the boundary wall, mubife feetpath, kerb and grass verges shall be reinstated not later than the lat day of April, 1977.

Column 1 - Conditions

- 2. The unauthorised access on to Templeogue Road shall be closed and the site reinstated prior to the commencement of use of the proposed temporary readway.
- Column 2 Reasons for Conditions
- 1. On completion of building operations on the site the temporary access will no longer be needed and it is desirable in the interests of amenity and traffic safety that the use of the access should cease.
- 2. In the interests of traffic safety and of whenity.
