In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/487/76 dated 20th February, 1976, decide to refuse:

~~OUTLINE PERMISSION:~~ PERMISSION; ~~APPROVAL~~

for proposed relocation of 89 No. dwellinghouses - group 9
Kilnamanagh Estate, Greenhills Road, Tallaght, Co. Dublin,
for the following reasons:

1. The proposed dwellinghouses are located on lands previously shown, coloured green, forming part of the approved public open space and referred to in condition No. 13 of the Grant of Permission by the Minister for Local Government, dated 5/3/73. The dwellinghouses now proposed on this public open space would contravene materially the grant of permission by the Minister for Local Government, and would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area and would seriously injure the amenities of the area.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
