for the following reasons: 1. This type of self contained residential unit in the back gardens of an existing estate of predominently single family residential units and having inadequate access to public roads and inadequate front and rear gardens would be seriously injurious to the residential amenity of the existing house and adjoining houses.

2. The applicant has not established that the proposed chimney is of sufficient height to adequately diffuse smoke therefrom without interference with the existing houses. The difficulty of raising the chimney is that it is likely to x be visually obtrusive.
