with reference to your Planning Application received here on the 4th November, 1975, in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963, the following additional information must be submitted in quadruplicate:

1. Details to be submitted of the applicant's interest in the site of the proposed community hall. In this regard the applicant is informed that ~~as~~ the site forms part of a small area of open space serving James Connolly Park and is owned and maintained by Dublin Council consent to use the site should be obtained before this planning application can be fully considered.
2. Details regarding the following to be submitted: (a) adequate and suitable Sanitary convenience for male and female to be indicated. (b) Details of hand washing facilities to be indicated. (c) Evidence of compliance with the requirements of the Food Hygiene Regulations 1950/71 (if applicable) to be indicated.

Prior to submitting information on point 1, above, the applicant is advised to contact the Community Affairs Section, Parnell Square. With regard to point 2, above the applicant is advised to consult with the Supervising Health Inspector, Eastern Health Board, Rutland Place.
