APPLICANT: Mills & Allen Ltd.

In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/2973/75. dated 17th Dec., '75. decide to refuse:

~~OUTLINE PERMISSION~~ PERMISSION; ~~APPROVAL~~.

for Proposed advertising panels at Rathfarnham Shopping Centre, Butterfield.

for the following reasons:

1. The proposed advertising panels by reason of their location within the shopping centre circulation and parking areas, would be likely to be a source of distraction and obstruction to both pedestrian and vehicle movements within the shopping curtilage of the Shopping Centre and would thus be likely to endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard.
2. The proposed advertising panels in close proximity to the existing residential estate would seriously injure the amenities of the adjoining residential properties.

Note: The applicant's are advised to consider the submission of a separate application for permission in respect of internal advertising proposals.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
