In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/409/76 dated 11th February, 1976. decide to refuse:

OUTLINE PERMISSION; ~~PERMISSION~~; ~~APPROVAL~~.

for Proposed extension to rear of Bank premises at 279, Templeogue Road,

for the following reasons:

1. The proposed development would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard because of the generation of the additional traffic movements to and from the site on this heavily trafficked National Secondary Route.
2. The existing site is likely to be seriously affected to a depth of approximately 40-ft., by the Council's future road improvement scheme for this section of the Templeogue Road.

The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
