A PERMISSION/APPROVAL has been granted for the development described below subject to the undermentioned conditions.

proposed Bus Shelter at Rathcoole Village at Community Hall.

Conditions	Reasons for Conditions
1. That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.	(1) To ensure that the development be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
(2) That the applicant makes satisfactory arrangements for the maintenance, repair and upkeep of the structure.	(2) In the interests of pedestrian safety and amenity.
(3) That the applicant accepts responsibility for the removal of the structure, at his own expense, if such is necessary, for the purpose of road widening, reconstruction or repair, and for the repair, replacement and renewal of any services installed in the public street.	(3) In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
(4) That the lighting of the panels be so controlled as not to cause excessive glare/distracton to road users, or adjoining property owners, and that the hours of lighting shall not extend beyond the normal hours of lighting of the adjoining street lights.	(4) In the interests of public safety and amenity.
(5) That the applicants indemnify the County Council against any claim made against the Authority as a result of the presence of the structure on public property.	(5) In the interests of the proper planning and development of the area.
(6) The proposed shelter is to be so located and so constructed as to provide free pedestrian passage along the existing footway at all times.	(6) In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
