(3) That the external finishes harmonise in colour and texture with the existing structures. (4) That the disposal of surface water be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council. Trade effluents are not to be discharged to the Council's drainage system. (5) That Building Bye-laws approval shall be obtained and any conditions of such approval shall be observed in the development.
