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A Chara,

With reference to your Planning Application received on the 29th
July, 1975 (Housing Act permission granted 5/3/76) in connection
with the above I wish to inform you that before your application
can be considered under the Local Government (Planning and
Development) Act, 1963, the following additional information must
be submitted in quadruplicate:-

1. The application as submitted is incomplete insofar as
it does not incorporate County Council's road proposals.
Revised plans are required showing these road proposals
and the affect they have on the proposed development.
2. The lodged plans do not show the first floor of the
building either on plan or elevation. In letter of
application to the Housing Department for permission
under the Housing Act it was stated that a fully
self-contained area for living accommodation was being
provided on the first floor of the premises. Information
is required with regard to this flat development
together with plan and elevation and measures to be taken
to insulate the residential accommodation from the licensed
premises.
