3. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer, be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.	3. In the interest of public safety and avoidance of fire hazard.
4. That the water supply and drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.	4. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
5. That a financial contribution in the sum of £415 (four hundred and fifteen pounds) be paid by the applicant to the Dublin County Council, towards the cost of provision of public services in the area of the proposed development and which facilitate this development; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on the site.	5. The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the cost of providing the services.
