The requirements of the Supervising Health Inspector, Sanitary Authority, to be ascertained, and adhered to in this development.</p> <p>4. Land expected to be required for road construction purposes to be reserved free of development and made available to the County Council when required.</p> <p>5. Lines of Western Parkway Motorway and Kannelsfort Road realignment to be set out on site by developer and checked by Roads Department before any development work takes place.</p> <p>6. 35-ft. kerb radii and adequate vision splays (i.e. 300-ft. in either direction from a setback of 15-ft. from edge of carriageway) be provided at access and egress points.</p> <p>7. That the proposed access road and car-park be considered to be a temporary development and to be removed from the site when the land for the realignment of Kannelsfort Road is required by the County Council.</p>	<p>1.
