In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order... P/2083/75... dated 11th July, 1975... decide to refuse:

~~OUTLINE PERMISSION~~; PERMISSION; ~~APPROVAL~~.

for .... Proposed mobile shop at Firhouse Road, Woodlawn Park, Templeogue

for the following reasons:

- (1) The site is located in or adjoining the Firhouse Road reservation for improvement purposes and is also situated in an area zoned to provide for the development of a residential community. The retention of this mobile shop would contravene materially this objective would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area and would seriously injure the amenities of the area.
- (2) The retention of this mobile shop on or immediately adjoining the Firhouse Road both existing and improved reservation would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard because of the abnormal pedestrian movements generated across the existing public road with the consequent vehicular congestion and dangerous stopping movements.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
