In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order **P/1878/75,** dated **27th June, 1975,** decide to refuse:

~~OUTLINE PERMISSION~~ PERMISSION; ~~APPROVAL~~

for **proposed illuminated and/or non-illuminated advertising displays**  
**at Firhouse Inn, Firhouse Road, Tallaght,**

for the following reasons:

- (1) The site is located in an area zoned to preserve an area of high amenity in the Development Plan. The advertising signs proposed by reason of their shape, size and location would contravene materially this objective, would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area and would seriously injure the amenities of the area.
- (2) The proposed advertizing signs by reason of their size and location, would endanger public safety by reason of the distraction caused to vehicular traffic on this heavily trafficked main road.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
