APPLICANT: The Bridges Group of Companies.

In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/1695/75.... dated 12th June, 1975, decide to refuse:

~~OUTLINE PERMISSION~~; PERMISSION; ~~APPROVAL~~,

for Proposed maintenance and assembly depot at Brounebarn, Clon-
dalkin.

for the following reasons:

- (1) The site proposed is located in an area zoned to provide for the further development of agriculture in the Development Plan. The development proposed would contravene materially this objective would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area and would seriously injure the amenities of the area.
- (2) Public piped sewerage facilities are not available to serve the proposed development.
- (3) The proposed development would be premature by reason of the said existing deficiency in the provision of sewerage facilities and the period within which such deficiency may reasonably be expected to be made good.
- (4) The proposed development would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard due to the generation of additional traffic turning movements from the large scale development proposed onto an adjoining Council road system and the Naas Road dual-carriageway National Primary Route.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
