<p>(1) That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.</p> <p>(2) That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained prior to commencement of development and complied with in full before the structures proposed in the development are put into use.</p> <p>(3) That the water supply and drainage arrangements, including the design, location and satisfactory operation of the proposed septic tank and private water supply arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council. The applicant must consult with the Health Inspector's Department, 9, Rutland Place, with regard to these matters before any constructional work takes place on the proposed dwellinghouse. The applicants must arrange for adequate water supply for the purpose of ensuring that an adequate supply for fire fighting purposes is available at all times.</p> <p>(4) That adequate and satisfactory landscaping scheme and programme for such works is to be submitted to and approved by the County Council.
