In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/4063/75 dated 17th Dec., '75.

decide to refuse: ~~OUTLINE PERMISSION;~~ PERMISSION; ~~APPROVAL.~~

for Proposed fish and chip shop unit with residential accommodation at 1st floor level at 3, Greenhills Road, Tallaght.

for the following reasons:

1. The site is located in an area zoned to preserve and improve residential amenity in the Development Plan. The commercial development proposed would contravene materially this objective, would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area and would seriously injure the amenities of the area.
2. The proposed development for commercial purposes in close proximity to the junction approach to Main Street, Tallaght, would be likely to endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard because of the additional vehicle movements to and from the site and the associated congestion within the junction approach area.
3. Portion of the site is likely to be seriously affected by the Council's major improvements for Greenhills Road.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
