In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/771/75 dated 20th March, 1975 decide to refuse:

~~OUTLINE PERMISSION~~; PERMISSION; ~~APPROVAL~~

for Proposed storage and machine sheds and canteen and toilet block at Adamstown.

for the following reasons:

1. The site of the proposal is located in an area indicated in the Development Plan with the objective "to provide for the further development of agriculture". The proposal is in conflict with this objective and with the proper planning and development of the area.
2. There are no public piped water or sewerage facilities available to serve the proposed development.
3. The proposed development would be premature by reasons of the said existing deficiency in the provision of water and sewerage facilities and the period within which such deficiency may reasonably be expected to be made good.
4. No satisfactory proposals for drainage have been submitted.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
