6. That off-street car parking facilities for the existing structure and proposed structures be in accordance with the requirements of the Development Plan.	6. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
7. That a financial contribution in the sum of £357 (three hundred and fifty seven pounds) be paid by the proposers to the County Council towards the cost of provision of public services in the area of the proposed development and which facilitate this development; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on the site.	7. The provision of such services in the area by the ERM Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the cost of providing the services.
