In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/706/75 dated 13th March, 1975 decide to refuse:

for Proposed temporary storage building at Fox and Geese,
Naas Road, Clondalkin,

for the following reasons:

1. The proposed development, with direct access to the Naas Road dual-carriageway National Primary Route, would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard because of the additional commercial vehicle movements to and from the site on this heavily trafficked National Primary Route.
2. Portion of the lands are seriously affected by the Council's future road proposals for this area.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
