(2) That permission shall cease to have effect after the expiration of one year from the receipt thereof by the applicant therefor and such time thereafter as is necessary for the Minister for Local Government to determine any appeal unless within that time approval has been notified to those matters referred to in condition (1) above. (3) The proposed development to provide for adequate future vehicular access to the lands to the east and to the west. In this regard the northern portion of the north/south block to be omitted from the development.	(3) In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
(4) That details regarding applicants interest in area of land to the north/west be indicated. In this regard the Planning Authority is of the opinion that this land should be incorporated into the redevelopment. Details of the existing structures in the north west corner to be submitted together with details of rights of way etc. that they may enjoy.	(4) In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
