OUTLINE PERMISSION; Proposed 160-No. dwellinghouses at R for the following reasons:	

- I. The site is located in an area zoned to provide for the further development of agriculture in the Development Plan. The residential development proposed would be in conflict with this objective and would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area.
- 2. Public piped services are not available to serve the proposal.
- 3. The proposed development is prematureby reason of the said existing deficiency in the provision of sewerage facilities and the period within which such deficiency may reasonably be expected to be made good.
- 4. The proposed development would be premature because a road layout for the area or part thereof has not been indicated in the Development Plan or has not been approved of by the Planning Authority or by the Minister on appeal.
