In pursuance of its functions under the above-mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by Order dated as above make a decision to grant Permission/Approval for **proposed bus shelter at Leman Road, opposite St. Loman's Hospital,**

SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS :

Conditions	Reasons for Conditions
(1) That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application, save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.	(1) To ensure that the development be in accordance with the permission and effective control maintained.
(2) That the applicant make satisfactory arrangements for the maintenance, repair and upkeep of the structure.	(2) In the interests of pedestrian safety and amenity.
(3) That the applicant accept responsibility for the removal of the structure, at his own expense, if such is necessary, for the purpose of road widening, reconstruction or repair, and for the repair, replacement and removal of any services installed in the public street.	(3) In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
(4) That the lighting of the panels be so controlled as not to cause excessive glare, distraction to road users, or adjoining property owners, and that the hours of lighting shall not extend beyond the normal hours of lighting of the adjoining street lights.	(4) In the interests of public safety and amenity.
(5) That the applicants indemnify the County Council against any claim made against the Authority as a result of the presence of the structure on public property.	(5) In the interests of the proper planning and development of the area.
(6) That an advertising be placed on side panels.	(6) In the interest of public safety.
(7) That an adequate stagger be introduced between this bus shelter and the one on opposite side of the road. The exact location of the bus shelter to be determined as a matter in consultation with the Road Engineer.	(7) In the interest of public safety.
