It is an objective of the Planning Authority that the (1) ares in which the site is located be reserved "to provide for the further development of agriculture". The factory for which outline permission was granted by the Minister was stated to be a precest concrete factory and provided for an internal batching plant. ... The prophest, now, to locate the betching plant in the open and to retail ready mixed concrete therefoon is not in accordance with the existing grant of permission. It would be injurious to, and incompatible with the agricultural zoning of the area end could lead to pollution of the atmosphere by dust from cement and aggregates.
