In pursurance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dubl dated	in, did by order P/3291/74,		
for change of use from haybarn to store for aluminium and to extend			
this store at Hazelhatch House, Hazelhatch, Newcastle, for the following reasons:			
 (1) It is an objective of the Planning Authority as expressed in the Development Plan that the area in which the site is located be reserved "To provide for the further development of agriculture." The proposed development would be incompatible with this zoning and would militate against the preservation of the rural environment. (2) The haybarn and yard in question form part of a larger agricultural holding. It is considered that this building and yard should be retained and used in relation to this agricultural holding and for purposes compatible thereto. (3) The storage of aluminium, particularly in scrap form, in this area would be most objectionable in relation to adjoining residential properties and farm holdings. (4) The proposed development would endanger public safety by reason of a traffic hazard due to the generation of traffic in the vicinity of a very harrow and dangerous bridge which has negligible sight lines.
