Conditions	Reasons for Conditions
(1) That permission shall cease to have effect after the expiration of one year from the receipt thereof by the applicant thereafter and such time thereafter as is necessary for the Minister for Local Government to determine any appeal unless within that time approval has been notified to those matters referred to in the conditions.	(1) In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
(2) That the exact location of the proposed fence on the western boundary be determined subsequent to consultations with the Planning Department and incorporated into plans to be submitted for approval.	(2) To secure the proper planning and development of the area.
(3) That details of the users of the existing Gallenstown Lane be submitted. That Gallenstown Lane must remain open until documentary evidence has been submitted; that all those legally entitled to the use of the lane no longer require the access, or have been provided with satisfactory alternative access.	(3) To secure the proper planning and development of the area.
(4) That the realignment of Killesh Road be determined subsequent to consultations with the Roads Engineer.	(4) To ensure a satisfactory standard of development.
