(1) The structure shall be removed from the site and the road surface shall be restored to its original conditions not later than the 31st July, 1976.	(1) It is considered necessary in the interests of the proper planning and development of the area to limit the period covered by the grant of permission to enable the position to be re-assessed in relation to the traffic movements then existing on Taylor's Lane, and on other roads in the area.
(2) Arrangements shall be made with the estate developers and the Roads Department of the Dublin County Council for the erection of the relevant temporary cul-de-sac sign posting, having regard to the location of the bollards.
