- 1. The hoardings by reason of location alongside a National Primary Route would constitute a serious distraction to road users and as such would induce serious traffic hazard.
- 2. The hoardings by reason of purpose and scale would endanger public safety by reason of a traffic hazard due to the distraction of road users.
- 3. The proposed development is contrary to the proper planning and development of the area because it is located in an area zoned in the Development Plan "to provide for light industrial development solely". Hoardings such as proposed would not be permissible in this area.
