APPLICANT: More O'Ferrall Ltd.

In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/2153/74 dated 5th July, 1974 decide to refuse:

~~OUTLINE PERMISSION:~~ PERMISSION; ~~APPROVAL~~

Proposed advertising structures at John F. Kennedy Drive, Naas Road.

for the following reasons:

1. The hoardings by reason of location alongside a National Primary Route would constitute a serious distraction to road users and as such would induce serious traffic hazard.
2. The hoardings by reason of purpose and scale would endanger public safety by reason of a traffic hazard due to the distraction of road users.
3. The proposed development is contrary to the proper planning and development of the area because it is located in an area zoned in the Development Plan "to provide for light industrial development solely". Hoardings such as proposed would not be permissible in this area. The only advertising permissible in this area are signs of identification for industrial units suitably located within the curtilage of their sites.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to the Minister by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
