A PERMISSION/APPROVAL has been granted for the development described below subject to the undermentioned conditions.

Proposed temporary local service centre at existing 38 Kv station at the east side of Belgard Road, Tallaght.

Conditions	Reasons for Conditions
(1) That the development be carried out and completed strictly in accordance with the plans and specification lodged with the application save as is in the conditions hereunder otherwise required.	(1) To ensure that the development be in accordance with the permission and effective control be maintained.
(2) That the structure shall be removed on or before 30th June, 1976, unless before that date permission for its retention is granted by the Planning Authority or by the Minister on appeal. Alternatively the temporary structure be removed if the Council's road improvement constructional works are put in hand before 30th June 1976.	(2) To enable the effect of the development on the amenities of the area to be reviewed, having regard to the conditions then obtaining.
(3) That the water supply and drainage arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.	(3) In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1984.
(4) That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer, if any, be strictly ascertained and adhered to in the development.	(4) In the interest of public safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.
(5) That any necessary land required for road improvement purposes be reserved as such and made available to the County Council.	(5) In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
