APPLICANT: In pursurance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/1888/74 dated 17th June, 1974 decide to refuse: PERMISSION; DOBEROVAL. Proposed bungalow at Glassamucky Brakes, Tallaght. Site area: one acre. Floor area:1,245-sq.ft. for the following reasons:

- 1. The site is located in an area zoned high amenity open space in the Development Plan. The development proposed would be in conflict with this objective would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area and would seriously injure the amenities of the area.
 - 2. Public piped services are not available to serve the proposal.
