In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order P/1559/74 dated 17th May, 1974. decide to refuse:

for the following reasons:

- (1) The dwellinghouse proposed on site Nos. 809, 810, 901, 902, 903, and 904, are located on a previously approved public open space, which was the subject of a decision to grant permission for the erection of 700-dwellinghouses at Springfield, by Order No. P/366/71, dated 22/2/1971, and the development now proposed on this previously approved open space would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area.

When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
