In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by orderP/1614/74.... dated23rd May, 1974..... decide to refuse:

for the following reasons:

1. The site is located in an area zoned - to preserve and improve residential amenity - in the Development Plan. The extensions proposed, which include a kindergarten classroom and excessive site coverage at the rear of the existing dwellinghouse, would be in conflict with this objective, would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area and would seriously injure the amenities of the area.

The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to the Secretary, (Planning Appeals Section), Department of Local Government, Custom House, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
